**Dear Parent**

On Tuesday 2 June, the Governing Body met and approved the proposed move from Community to Foundation status, following the period of Statutory Notice. This will take effect from 1 September, 2009. As indicated in the original rationale, the Governing Body feel that the increased autonomy, and, in particular, the sense of self-reliance that comes with Foundation status, will help the school in its continued commitment to provide an excellent education for all the children in the local area.

As part of this commitment, we have two events planned for this final half-term, in which I would like to invite your views and opinions on how we can further improve what we do.

Firstly, in the week beginning Monday 8 June, we shall be sending home our annual Parent and Student surveys. The results of last year's surveys are on our website, and helped us identify strengths, on which to build, and areas for further development.

Secondly, we have a Parent Liaison Meeting on Thursday 11 June at 7.00 pm. We shall be outlining our Science College plan and our development of a Virtual Learning Environment, and having discussion groups on our proposed revised policies for Behaviour for Learning and Equality and Diversity.

It would be a very real help to our improvement strategies if you were able to complete and return the parent survey, and we would, of course, be delighted if you could join us at the parent liaison meeting.

Please could I also draw your attention to our newsletter "News@Moulton" which is available each half-term on our website.

Finally, I would like to take the opportunity to thank you for your on-going support, and hope that through activities such as the surveys, and events such as the parents' liaison meeting, we are able to further build effective partnerships.
