



ADMISSIONS POLICY

The school follows criteria laid down by Northamptonshire County Council.

In the event of over-subscription, places for September 2012 will be allocated in the following order of priority:

To children in public care (“looked-after children”), and to children with Statements of Educational Need whose statements specify Moulton School

- ii. To pupils who live in the linked area associated with Moulton School, i.e., Boughton, Brixworth, Scaldwell, Harlestone, Althorp, Moulton, Moulton Leys, Overstone, Pitsford, Sywell, The Bramptons, Walgrave, Hannington, Holcot and Old
- iii. To pupils who will have an older brother or sister continuing at Moulton School in September 2012.
- iv. To pupils attending, on 31st October 2011, Moulton School’s designated contributory primary schools (i.e., Boughton, Brixworth, Harlestone, Moulton, Overstone, Pitsford, Sywell, The Bramptons and Walgrave) and continuing in attendance until the formal offer of places is made.
- v. To other pupils.

If the admission number is exceeded within category ii, priority will be given to those who live furthest from the nearest alternative school. If the admission number is exceeded within any other category, priority will be given to those who live closest to the school.
