

Homework Policy

We consider regular homework important because it enables students to develop independent study skills that will be of value to them in exam courses and in life beyond school. Homework is also important because it involves parents in their children's work.

There is a timetable to ensure that homework is distributed evenly throughout the week. We issue a Student Planner to all students and require them to note in it the work set each day and the date of its completion. We encourage students to plan their time so that assignments are completed by the required date.

There is space for parents to sign the planner each week and to communicate with their child's form tutor. Parents who have a question or concern about homework should contact their child's Head of House.
