**Science**

Richard Tudor presented a paper on the results in science. This identified strengths and areas for improvement.

**Maths**

Linda Davies presented a paper on the results in maths.

Results in both maths and science were above national averages, but improvements are needed in terms of value added. Short and medium term plans are being put in place for both subjects.

**School plan**

A number of science led projects were developed within school. These include the introduction of the L3 extended project, coaching to improve staff performance and the science challenge day.

Within the community, the main focus has been the primary schools. These links have continued to develop well.
