

ADMISSIONS & APPEALS POLICY

The school's published admission number (PAN) in September 2020 for Years 7 to 11 is 240 students.

The school uses the following criteria when determining admissions. Places will be allocated to pupils who have an EHC Plan that names the school as appropriate provision. In the event of over-subscription, places for September 2020, and for in-year admissions, will be allocated in the following order of priority:

- i. To looked after children and all previously looked after children. Previously looked after children are children who were looked after, but ceased to be so because they were adopted (or became subject to a child arrangements order or special guardianship order).
- ii. To students who live in the linked area associated with Moulton School, i.e., Boughton, Buckton Fields, Brixworth, Scaldwell, Harlestone, Althorp, Moulton, Moulton Leys, Overstone, Overstone Leys, Pitsford, Sywell, Church Brampton, Chapel Brampton, Walgrave, Hannington, Holcot and Old.
- iii. To students attending, at the time of application, Moulton School's designated contributory primary schools (i.e., Boughton, Brixworth, Harlestone, Moulton, Overstone, Pitsford, Sywell, The Bramptons and Walgrave), and continuing in attendance until the formal offer of places is made.
- iv. To students who are children of staff employed by the school in either or both of the following circumstances:
 - Where the member of staff has been employed at the MSSC for two or more years at the time at which the application for admission to MSSC is made;
 - The member of staff is recruited to fill a vacant post for which there is a demonstrable skills shortage.
- vi. To students who will have a brother or sister continuing at Moulton School in the year of admission, or at the time of admission for an in-year admission.
- vii. To other students.

Tiebreaker

If the admission number is exceeded within any criterion, priority will be given to those who live closest to the school. Distances are measured from the address point of the home address to the address point of the school on a straight line basis, using a geographical information system.

Appeals

All admission applications and appeals are administered through the local authority, and in accordance with their published time-scales. For further information regarding admissions please contact Sue Rose, Admissions Officer at the school.
